# 5. Projector Hardware Structure (From left to right)

#### Please open the package and check the following accessories:

Top Panel: Power(Indicator), D-pad, Return, Handle Front Panel: Tof, Lens Left and right Panels: Ventilation holes (Do not block) Rear Panel: USB-C DC IN, HDMI 2.1, IR receiver, USB 2.0, 3.5 mm Audio out Bottom Panel: PTZ bracket socket







# 6. Remote Control

#### The remote control layout, described from left to right and top to bottom, is as follows:

Part one: Standby, Source

Part two: YouTube, Netflix, Prime Video, Disney+

Part Three: Focus, Projector Settings

Part Four: Google Account profile, Google Assistant (center), Settings

Part Five (Circular tactile area): Directional Keys (outer ring), Enter (center)

Part Six: Back, Mute button (center), Home

Part Seven: Volume Down / Up



# **Bluetooth Pairing (Auto Mode)**

**Step 1:** Turn on the projector and wait for the bluetooth pairing prompt on the screen. Bring the remote control within 10 cm / 0.33 ft from the projector.

**Step 2:** Press and hold "BACK" and "HOME" keys simultaneously for 3 seconds. Release the keys after the indicator light starts flashing.

**Step 3:** Wait until you see Pairing Successful message on screen, indicating a successful pairing.

Note: Press and hold the "DOWN" and "BACK" keys for 5 seconds to activate the TalkBack function, once accessibility mode is enabled, you should hear the system's voice broadcast.

Kindly reminder, if the voice announcement is not audible, please repeat steps 1 and 2.

### 7. Placement

#### The remote control layout, described from left to right and top to bottom, is as follows:



Image Size	60 inches	80 inches	100 inches
Screen (Length * Width)	133 * 75 cm	177 * 100 cm	221 * 124 cm
Projection Distance	160 cm	213 cm	266 cm

The best recommended projection size is 80 inches.

### 8. Power on

- 1. Connect the projector to the power outlet.
- 2. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn on the projector.



# 9. Standby Mode / Power off

Press the power button on the projector or remote control to enter standby mode. Press and hold the power button on the projector or remote control for 3 seconds to turn off the projector

# **10. Network Settings**

Go to [Settings], select [Network & Internet], and turn on Wi-Fi. Choose your network and enter the correct password.



# **11. Focus Settings**

Go to [Dash board] and enter [Setting], select [Focus], and choose either manual focus or autofocus.

#### Autofocus

Select [Auto Focus] to trigger the autofocus function. The projector will adjust focus automatically.

#### **Manual focus**

Select [Manual Focus] and use the navigation keys (up / down) on the remote control to adjust the focus until the image is clear and sharp.



# **12. Keystone Correction**

Go to [Projector] -- [Image Correction].

Select [Auto Keystone Correction], and the screen will automatically be corrected.

Select [Manual Keystone Correction], and use navigation keys to adjust the four points and the image shape.



### 13. Bluetooth Speaker Mode

- 1. Go to [Settings], select [Projector], and click on [Bluetooth Speaker Mode].
- 2. When you hear "Bluetooth connection successful", the projector can play music from your phone.
- 3. Connect your phone to a device with the Bluetooth name containing "PG35B".
- 4. Press and hold the "BACK" key on remote control for 2 seconds to [Bluetooth speaker mode].



# 14. Google Assistant

Your TV is more helpful than ever. Use your voice to find movies, stream apps, play music and control your projector. Ask Google Assistant to find a specific title, search by genre, or get personalized recommendations. Even get answers on screen, control smart home devices, and more. Press the Google Assistant button on the remote to get started.



# **15. Screen mirroring with Google Cast<sup>™</sup> and Apple AirPlay**

Google Cast is a platform that lets you stream your favorite entertainment from your phone, tablet or laptop right to your projector. Easily control your projector with apps you already know and love from your iPhone®, iPad®, Android<sup>™</sup> phone or tablet, Mac® or Windows® laptop, or Chromebook. #### 1. Screen mirroring with Google Cast

- ① Connect your device and the projector to the same wireless network.
- ② Open a Google Cast-enabled app on your device.
- ③ Select the content you would like to cast, then tap the Cast icon.
- ④ Select "PG35B" to connect. The projector will display the content from your device.

#### 2. Screen Mirroring via AirScreen

#### You can mirror the entire screen from your device onto projector screen.

- ① Ensure that both your device and the projector are connected to the same wireless network.
- ② Install AirScreen AirPlay & Cast app on your projector.
- ③ Open AirScreen app and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the process.



# 16. Input

Go to [Inputs] -- HDMI/HOME, select and watch content from different signal sources. Open [IMPlayer] in app list and watch content from USB storage devices.



# **17. More Settings**

#### **1. Picture Mode**

Go to [Settings] -- [Display & Sound] -- [Picture] -- [Color Picture Mode Temperature] to select from different picture modes.

#### 2. Projection Mode

Go to [Settings] -- [Projector] -- [Advanced Settings] -- [Projection Mode] to choose the projection orientation.

#### 3. Zoom

Go to [Settings] -- [Projector] -- [Image Correction] -- [Image Adaption] to rescale the image size from 100% to 50%.

#### 4. System & Product Info

Go to [Settings] -- [System] -- [About] to check System & Product information.

### **19. Troubleshooting**

#### 1. No audio output

- a. Check if the projector is muted. If so, press [Mute] key again to unmute the projector.
- b. Check if the projector interface "HDMI ARC" or Bluetooth is connected to an external audio device.

#### 2. No image output

- a. Press [Power] button at the rear of the projector. The power indicator light will turn on if the projector enters projection mode successfully.
- b. Ensure that the power adaptor has specified power output.

#### 3. No network

- a. Enter [Setting] via [Dash board], and check the internet connection status in the network option.
- b. Ensure that the network cable is correctly inserted to the projector interface "LAN".
- c. Ensure that the router is correctly configured.

#### 4. Fuzzy Image

- a. Adjust the focus or keystone correction of the projector.
- b. Make sure the projection distance is in the effective focal range of the projector.
- c. Remove the dust or dirt from the lens with a blower or soft-bristled brush .

#### 5. Non-rectangular Image

- a. Place the projector perpendicular to the screen/wall if keystone correction function is not used.
- b. Use the keystone correction function to adjust image shape.

#### 6. Automatic keystone correction failure

a. Make sure the ToF module on the front glass cover of the projector is not blocked or smudged. b. Move the projector until it is perpendicular to the projection surface and try again.

#### 7. Autofocus failure

a. Make sure the ToF module on the front glass cover of the projector is not blocked or smudged.

b. Move the projector back and forth until the projector is in recommended projection distance.

#### 8. Remote control unresponsive

- a. Make sure the batteries are installed correctly and not drained.
- b. Remove any obstructions between your projector and remote control.
- c. Ensure the remote control is successfully paired with projector via Bluetooth.
- d. Make sure no button is pressed or stuck and check if the power indicator is still on. If yes, please contact customer support or local service center.

#### 9. Connect the Bluetooth devices

Enter [Settings], open the [Bluetooth] option to check the bluetooth device list, and connect the device.

#### 10. Cannot power on the projector

The projector will enter protection mode if the internal battery runs out. In this case, make sure the projector is connected to power supply and then press and hold the power button on projector or remote control for 3 seconds to power on the projector. In other cases, please contact customer support or local service center.

# 20. Important Precautions
